Due TOMORROW, January 30

Enrollment paperwork for families currently enrolled at CCA is due tomorrow, January 30. Please turn paperwork/registration fee into the basket in the office labeled "ADMIN INBOX." Receiving paperwork by this deadline is very helpful for planning and budgeting for the following year, so we thank you in advance for your promptness in this matter. Thank you for being sure to turn in the "Returning Student Registration Form" (this went home and can also be found on our website) as well as the appropriate registration fee.

Changes to Paying Tuition
