This event is an opportunity for parents to hear collectively from the administration about CCA policies and procedures. Parents will also hear directly from teachers regarding classroom policy. All parents will start on the lower level of the building and will later be dismissed to attend two 20 minute sessions in their child's classroom (one session per teacher). For families of multiple children at CCA, it may be helpful for both parents to attend different classroom sessions. **It is very important each family prioritize attending this event.** Please note that this is for parents only, so plan for childcare accordingly. Specials Start NEXT THURSDAY, September 19

CCA will be offering three different specials classes for the fall semester: Art, Music (learning to play the recorder for grades), and Photography/Yearbook. Sign up forms and a schedule of these classes can be found near Chere's desk and will be at Back to School Night. The deadline to sign up is Tuesday, September 17 for



the fall semester classes. Specials are \$35/mo. for the first child in each family and \$30/mo. for each consecutive child in the same family for the same special. **New this year, CCA is requesting specials be paid by semester rather than per month.** September will be half price, all other months will be charged full payment. First semester specials tuition will be due September 26. Please pay by check and place in the tuition folder in Cherese's office. Parents unable to make the semester payment can contact CCA's Financial Manager (finance@christiancoreacademy.org) and she is happy to work with you on a payment plan. Students K-5th grade need to be signed out by a parent during pick up after specials. Middle school students can be released to go directly to their parent's car in the parking lot. Please pick up your child when their special is complete. A study hall will be provided as needed for students who need to stay until their sibling's class is complete.

Art (K-8th)

There is a one-time \$15.00 art fee per child which covers the cost of supplies for the entire school year. This fee is due on the first day of art class, please hand it directly to Ms. Davis.

Music (3rd-8th)

Music class for 3rd-5th grades has a one-time fee of \$10 to purchase a recorder. Middle School students will have a one-time fee of \$30 for their instrument (a larger size recorder). Please hand this fee directly to the music teacher on the first day of specials.

Photography/Yearbook (Middle School)

Each student needs to bring their own device that has the ability to take pictures. They will also need access to a laptop they can bring to school during spring semester to use yearbook software.

Staff Luncheon – September 25

The CCA staff has a monthly luncheon to provide comradery and training. CCA will provide the lunch for September, however, each class will provide lunch for the remaining months of the year. Classroom Volunteer Coordinators in each class will notify parents of their designated month and will coordinate food for that luncheon. CCA Fall Festival

- Tickets for the **chicken drop bingo** will be sold for \$20 a square at the event. If you buy a square for \$10, and are lucky enough for a chicken to poop on your square, you will win \$50! You do not have to be present to win, so collect money from grandparents, neighbors and friends beforehand who would like to support our school.
