## **FRIENDLY REMINDERS**

**Nut Safe School**—CCA is a nut safe school. This means we do not allow peanuts or peanut products at any time, however, other nuts are allowed so long as your child's classroom does not have signs stating otherwise. We have a designated table in the lunch area that needs to remain free of ANY nuts at all times so children who need to stay away from nuts have the ability to do so. Thank you for helping us keep CCA students safe.

**Arriving to School on Time**—It is very important to get your child to school no later than 7:45am for K-8<sup>th</sup> grade students. It is a huge distraction when students are arriving 5-10 minutes into class time. Thank you for respecting our school hours.
